AUTHOR'S NOTES:

This month's New Moon falls on America's birthday, and as with an individual who experiences this, hopefully it represents a year of new beginnings for our nation. This year has been fraught with serious problems and unsureness. We seem to be floundering in a sea of insecurity and anger that threatens to upend much of the good so many have tried to accomplish. We have some very difficult issues that must be addressed, and how we face them will have long term effects on our country and the world. By the end of this month both political parties will have had their conventions and formally named their candidates for the highest office in the land. And soon this political quagmire will be settled once and for all. We all have our strong opinions about the coming election. In any case, I wish you all a very happy holiday and a long and delightful summer. And I wish America, a country that I truly love and admire, a most glorious birthday.

We will be experiencing a number of difficult and potentially explosive transits this month. They are all quick moving, so hopefully we can avoid any major problems. But still there are a few that require our close attention.

On July 7th we will see Mercury and the Sun opposite Pluto, and Venus square Uranus. Alone each of these could represent a stressful moment. But together they imply that this will be a day to keep your eyes open and avoid dangerous situations or direct conflicts. People will be stressful and could easily overreact. This may be a day when some event or news comes out that is quite disturbing. The moon will be void of course all day, which implies that whatever does occur will be unhinged and possibly misunderstood or blown out of proportion. In any case, I suggest that we all use caution and respect these transits. View the aspects below for that day to get a better idea of what we can expect.

We will also have Mercury square Uranus July 11th and the Sun square Uranus July 16th. These are two more days when caution and common sense are called for. So keep this in mind, and perhaps mark these dates on your calendar to remind yourself. Awareness is all, and keeping your eyes open will make the difference.

Brixet has had a tremendous effect on the world, both financially and psychologically. Our stock markets have recovered the losses we had when the news was released. But that doesn't mean we aren't in for more difficult times ahead. The long term effects of the British decision will be seen over the next year as the reality of what this means sets in. The Brits are beginning to see the results of what isolationism can lead to, and already they don't like it. I hope Americans are paying attention.

The next president will appoint at least one, most likely up to three Supreme Court Justices. The result will be that for the next 30 years our societal direction will be decided by the choices made over the next year. No matter who is elected their influence will far outlive their time in the White House. We are at a precipice in human history where the very planet we live on will be affected and the course we choose could have unimaginable results.

The direction our country takes now will decide so many important issues that this election's importance cannot be overstated. We have people who, despite the horrific changes in our weather patterns, sea levels

and other indicators refuse to believe in climate change. It's much more than being on the wrong side of history, it's threatening our very existence. It is possible that the Environmental Protection Agency would be defunded or even dissolved, along with many other programs and laws that we have fought for decades to protect.

Anyone looking for a squeaky clean politician had better look on Mars. You will not find it on this planet. It is the nature of the game that through mistakes, compromises and personal decisions all of them have baggage and stains. So choose carefully when you enter that ballot box. Your decision will weigh heavily on your children.

As we approach the end of the Saturn – Neptune square in September some clarity will return. By autumn much of what has happened this year will be put into a different perspective and many people will feel as though a fog has been lifted. But first we are going to have both parties' conventions this month, and the results will be a good indicator of what to expect this fall. The Republicans have their convention on the Capricorn Full Moon. I expect it to be a strange and possibly violent few days. There is so much anger in the collective that planning this shindig right on a Full Moon is almost biblical in its potential. While Capricorn isn't as volatile a sign as some, and in fact tends to be a bit understated, it will still bring up questions of what is most important to the collective and the long-term issues that this Saturn ruled sign is most interested in. It may be calmer than I expect because it is in this sign. But there is nothing superficial or ordinary in anything we as a society are facing now.

The world is in a strange place right now. Xenophobia and isolationism is gaining ground in a number of places. As I said above, the British have just learned that independence and seclusion in our modern world amounts to a shrinking of influence and limitations on growth and prosperity. If our nation chooses that path we will pay an enormous price.

During the 1930s as much of the rest of the world chose Chauvinistic nationalism and Mussolini, Hitler, Franco, Stalin and Hirohito rose to power, America elected, reelected, and reelected F.D.R. who literally saved not just America but the world. He refused to heed the anger and frustration that the great depression had created. Had we given into our own strong isolationist tendencies, the world would be a much different place today. And not for the better, no matter what you may think. Those who lived through that era know. Those who didn't should study history before voting.

NEW MOON:

The New Moon falls on Monday July 4th at 7:01 A.M. EDT at 12 degrees Cancer 54 minutes. The Cancer New Moon is all about the past, family and emotions. This is a month for us all to get more in touch with our feelings and to analyze our attitudes about these issues and perhaps to make alterations in how we approach those closest to us. It's also a time to view our connection to the past. What are you holding onto that is no longer valid? Are there some feelings that are holding back your growth? And if so, what can you do about it? Cancer is depicted as the crab, with a hard shell but soft meat inside. And that is quite an accurate description. Cancers can be difficult to approach. They tend to be self-protective and it can take some time to find an opening into that inner sanctum. But once you are allowed in the crab can be a most welcoming and compassionate sign. The same is true within ourselves as we enter this period. Mercury and Venus are in Cancer now, so there is a great deal of this emotional energy circling around us. No matter what sign you were born under, as these planets transit this cardinal water sign we will all be more in touch with our inner self and have to contend with some of the issues that are normally the domain of the water signs. We all must experience all 12 of the signs in order to fully develop as individuals. This is the time to deal with familial and emotionally charged situations. How you handle it will have much to do with who you are to begin with. Just try to keep an open mind and don't judge yourself or others for action more demonstrative or sensitive about things. It's interesting that this year the Cancer New Moon falls on America's birthday as we approach what is perhaps the most important election our nation has seen in a generation. It's time for our country and its inhabitants to explore our past and to learn from it so we can make the right decisions about our future.

MERCURY TRINES NEPTUNE:

On Tuesday July 5th at 8:20 A.M. EDT this creative aspect completes. This is a good transit for all creative projects. Artists will especially find a good energy around this, but it also heightens our intuition no matter what profession you pursue. Anyone who uses their inner voice will feel comfortable with this aspect. Try to use it to your advantage. Conversations will perhaps take on a somewhat spacy atmosphere, but if you can focus your attention your instincts will help you say the right thing. Pay more attention to you sensitivity and intuition and less to your intellect.

VENUS TRINES MARS:

On Wednesday July 6th at 4:17 P.M. EDT the male and female planets are in a positive configuration. This is a good day for interaction between the sexes. There is a good balance and it will be easier than usual to cross that great divide that separates men and women. If this sets off a sensitive point in your chart, this could lead to a friendship or possibly even a romantic encounter. But while friendship will flourish today, it isn't the strongest transit for romance. Just enjoy the balance within yourself as well as in the connections with others. This can be a very creative transit as the ego power of Mars is working well with the artistic nature of Venus. So if you're working on something creative, give it a push today. In any case you should enjoy any form of entertainment or art that is available. You will get more out of it and it should make you feel fulfilled and satisfied.

THE SUN CONJUNCTS MERCURY:

Also on Wednesday July 6th at 11:24 P.M. EDT this frequent conjunction completes. This can be a very willful aspect, and you will probably find people less likely to bend or change their minds. There is a lot of energy around communications, and if you have something to say this is a good time to say it. Just be aware of that willfulness and try not to speak in a pushy or arrogant fashion. Arguments are possible, so decide where your breaking point is. If you can be more flexible than the other person you may be able to accomplish much. But if you are too rigid you might not be able to move a conversation to its necessary conclusion. Expect to be busy with emails, phone calls, etc.

MERCURY OPPOSES PLUTO:

On Thursday July 7th at 7:54 A.M. EDT this very difficult transit comes along. This is an argument waiting to happen. It's not a good time to have any important discussion that requires compromise or finding a middle ground. Both sides will be stubborn and unyielding, and it could be a very frustrating situation. However, if you do get into a conversation you can be sure that there will be a strong attempt at uncovering the truth. Pluto strips away all the layers and gets to the heart of the matter. Mercury is all about communications, so obviously it will be in our dialogue that this desire to unearth the truth will be most effective. If you're not willing to hear what the other person has to say, avoid any serious conversations until later in the day when this aspect has waned. Use caution while traveling. Road rage is very possible, and you could be the recipient of someone else's anger.

VENUS SQUARES URANUS:

Also on Thursday July 7th at 10:24 A.M. EDT this erratic transit will add more stress to the Mercury opposite Pluto mentioned above. This aspect will create some nervousness and irritability that will be obvious. Many people will be stressed out for a while. This will be especially true in close personal relationships. It's not a good day for a delicate conversation with a close friend or significant other. There will be little sensitivity and disagreements are very possible. With the Sun also in opposition to Pluto later tonight (see below) compromise and balance will be in short order. Try to take a step back and look at the situation from all perspectives. If you can avoid a direct confrontation or delay a dispute for a day or so it would probably be a good idea.

THE SUN OPPOSES PLUTO:

Also on Thursday July 7th at 6:24 P.M. EDT this rough transit completes this trilogy of harsh aspects. As I said above, this is not a good day for a direct battle. Nobody will win, and there could be some bad feelings

as a result of what is said. If you can put off having that serious conversation you will be doing yourself a big favor. Many people will be feeling edgy and uncomfortable without knowing why. You'd be better off discussing things tomorrow when Mercury is in sextile to Jupiter and a more complacent attitude will prevail. Today is an opportunity to reach deeply inside of yourself and your relationships to examine what is going on and what needs to be altered. It's just not a good day to express it all. It may be quite difficult for some to hold back their feelings, but that is exactly what I recommend.

MERCURY SEXTILES JUPITER:

On Friday July 8th at 5:06 A.M. EDT this pleasant and easy going aspect will cool off some of the anger and angst following the three difficult transits we experienced yesterday. People will be in a better mood for the most part, and it will be much easier to get your point across without stirring up opposition. This sextile favors travel, education and anything that expands your mind and open you up to new ideas. It is followed in a few days by several other great transits, so this should be a good weekend for many. Get out and look at the world from a new perspective. The more positive you approach things the more you will gain from them. This includes relationships, work and entertainment. If you've been having a hard time with someone and wish to improve the connection, this weekend will afford you the opportunity to smooth things over.

THE SUN SEXTILES JUPITER:

On Sunday July 10th at 1:41 A.M. EDT this wonderfully positive and expansive aspect will bring us all an opportunity to experience new things. Try to explore the world. Although this completes early in the morning and its effects will be felt more the night before, it sets up the energy for Sunday and it followed by the also positive Mercury trine Mars mentioned below. Today you should be looking at the bigger picture and not get caught up too much in the small details. This is a good weekend for travel or anything that will expand your perspective. Don't sit around the house. Get out and see the world.

MERCURY TRINES MARS:

Also on Sunday July 10th at 10:00 P.M. EDT this excellent trine will allow us to communicate with force but without anger or frustration. This combination will bring a strong voice to the conversation, and people will certainly say what's on their minds. That's not a bad thing, though sometimes with a conjunct or opposition between these two planets opinions will come out in a harsh and derisive tone pushing the other person to act defensively. Today that won't be the situation, unless one of you has other aspects that overpower this one. Now you can state your case in a direct and honest manner without it sounding offensive or rash. This is also a good day to travel. There will be energy behind the trip and things should go smoothly. Tomorrow with Mercury in square to Uranus this easy attitude will disappear, so take advantage of this and enjoy your Sunday.

MERCURY SQUARES URANUS:

On Monday July 11th at 3:29 A.M. EDT this difficult and erratic square will make it more difficult to express yourself without stirring up opposition. Many people will feel nervous, especially if this sets off a sensitive point in their chart. People will be apt to say what's on their mind without any forethought or filter. Tension, stress and anger may very well be expressed and once something is said it will be very hard to retract. Caution is certainly called for in communication, but also in travel. Because of Uranus' erratic and unpredictable nature it will be very easy to be distracted. Accidents are very possible as a result. Misunderstandings will abound, and any minor issue that occurs could easy be blown out of proportion. Use care and pay attention to what you're doing. A momentary diversion could end up causing a big problem.

VENUS ENTERS LEO:

On Tuesday July 12th at 1:34 A.M EDT until August 5th Venus will be in this boisterous sign. Romance will take on a decidedly theatrical tone as people play roles and try to show off for each other. Keep a sense of humor and you can enjoy this placement. It isn't the gentlest area for the planet of love to transit, and the sensitivity we experienced while Venus was transiting Cancer will not be there, but there is a great youthfulness and joy of life about Leo. If you go into a situation looking for fun you may find it. If you expect

great compassion and a tender hand you may be disappointed. This is a very good placement for all games and childlike activities, so take a trip, go out for a fun evening, or pursue entertainment of all sorts. The child within you will be grateful.

MERCURY ENTERS LEO:

On Wednesday July 13th at 8:47 P.M. EDT Mercury joins Venus in this fixed fire sign. Where people tended to speak with a gentle and emotional voice this past few weeks, now they will be more outspoken and direct. This placement is very good for actors and anyone who plans to make a public presentation. There is a bit of stubbornness as with all the fixed signs, but the childlike undercurrent of Venus and Mercury in this sign should allow us to laugh some of it off and reach a place of enjoyment and entertainment. Leo rules the 5th house of romance and creativity, so try to see situations from that perspective. If you approach things without preconceived ideas of what you expect and have a looser and adventurous attitude you can have a very good time. Take a vacation somewhere new and exciting if you can. If not, try to find things in your hometown that are playful.

THE SUN SQUARES URANUS:

On Saturday July 16th at 9:31 A.M. EDT this very unpredictable aspect completes. People may be irritable and easily angered. There will be an explosive energy in the air, so keep that in mind when you go about your business. Try to avoid direct confrontations and sidestep any disputes that are not absolutely necessary. There will be tension and stress and it will be easy to get into arguments about the smallest things. This is usually a very bad aspect for the stock markets, and with the Full Moon in Capricorn falling next Tuesday I wouldn't be surprised by a big move in the equities, most likely to the down side. Any bad news that comes out now will have a powerful effect on the markets. If you're traveling, you must use caution and pay attention to what you're doing. If you are feeling angry, you should not be behind the wheel of a car.

MERCURY CONJUNCTS VENUS:

Also on Saturday July 16th at 6:00 P.M. EDT this pleasant aspect completes. This will help a bit with the Sun square Uranus mentioned above, but it is not as powerful an aspect. It will however bring a gentler voice to conversations as it applies. But you still must be careful of what you say and how you say it. If you can put any anger or tension you are feeling aside, and avoid direct confrontations, you will find that communications of all sorts are enjoyable. Short journeys will bring much pleasure, but again pay heed to that more difficult square and use common sense.

THE SUN TRINES MARS:

Also on Saturday July 16th at 11:45 P.M. EDT this positive trine will also help somewhat in handling the Sun square Uranus. This trine will allow us to direct any excessive energy into positive projects and events, and if used properly it will give us an outlet for that force. Remember, all aspects are just energy. It's what we do with them that create the results. The wise person is aware of what is happening and seeks ways of aiming the energy where it can do the most good. If you pay attention to how you are feeling and communicating you can avoid much of the difficulty of that Sun – Uranus square. This trine completes just before midnight, and it may increase our vigor and vitality. You should not just sit home and watch TV. With this trine the more you use it the better the results will be.

MERCURY TRINES SATURN:

On Tuesday July 19th at 2:28 A.M. EDT this positive and very reality oriented transit will help us put our thoughts in order. This isn't a very exciting or adventurous transit, but it has a good purpose. We can all view our lives and objectives in a realistic perspective and aim our attention where it is most needed. Use the day or so leading up to this transit to put your work in order. Clean up any paperwork or make plans for your future projects. This is a good day to clean house, so to speak, whether you actually wash the floors or just make notes on what you're working on. Travel should run smoothly, but lack some of the excitement of other trips.

FULL MOON:

This month's lunar peak occurs on Tuesday July 19th at 6:56 P.M. EDT at 27 degree Capricorn 40 minutes. The Capricorn Full Moon will bring up issues that have reached a critical point in our lives and require our attention. Because this sign is ruled by reality-oriented Saturn, it has more to do with our finances, career, and status and less to do with personal issues. But with the Sun transiting in opposite Cancer there will be an emotional side to things as well. Any problems involving money or the structure of a project could come to a head now. Remember that the energy of the Full Moon lasts until the next New Moon, so it could happen anytime in the next 2 _ weeks. Pay attention to the details and look over your work and partnerships to make sure they are doing okay. If not, you should make some proactive efforts to improve things before a crisis occurs. This is also true in our society. The collective will also be susceptible to problems in any areas that haven't been shored up.

Of course because of the ongoing political circus we are experiencing, there could be some important news regarding one or more of the candidates. The Republican convention is scheduled for July $18^{th} - 21^{st}$, just as this Full Moon hits. The Democratic convention is July $25^{th} - 28^{th}$, right in the middle of this waning lunar cycle. I expect some major turnabouts at both of their meetings, and it's quite possible that there will be some very upsetting events that could disrupt the activities or push things in a new or unexpected direction. The Republicans are more at risk of a serious commotion with this lunar peak occurring just as they are set to announce their candidate. In any case, the energy of this Capricorn Full Moon will make it very clear as to where the cracks are in each party's platforms.

As with all Full Moons I suggest that in your own life you pay attention and give this energy the respect it deserves for a few days.

VENUS TRINES SATURN:

On Wednesday July 20th at 9:20 A.M. EDT there will be a serious and realistic approach to relationships. Because this is a positive trine it will be easier to absorb the information and use it productively. People will be clear and concise about their feelings, and there will be little room for frivolity or superficiality. Most of us will have the desire to get to the heart of the matter and to really understand what the other person is saying. Pay close attention to what is being said. This trine will allow us to make alterations in our connections and direct things into a more productive and positive way. This will be most prominent in close personal relationships, but also true in friendships and business associations. This is a good day to make up a budget or put business issues on the right track.

THE SUN ENTERS LEO:

On Friday June 22nd at 5:30 A.M. EDT we enter the fixed part of summer. Where last month was about family and the past, this month will be more about friendships, romance and playing. Now it's more about you as an individual or part of a close personal unit. It's a good time to plan a vacation with your lover or close friend. Leo rules the stage and with Mercury and Venus already in this sign you can expect some dramatics and public displays. This is a good time to make a presentation or for exposing any creative project to the public. Leo rules the 5th house of children, creativity and romance, so get out there and play. The child within us all needs some space to express itself. This is a good time to allow that.

MERCURY TRINES URANUS:

On Wednesday June 27th at 3:45 A.M. EDT our minds will be moving at a fast pace and ideas will come quickly and without restrictions. This trine is a very positive connection between the lower and higher minds, and it will be easier to express unusual or complicated ideas for a day or so leading us to this. Even though this is a positive aspect, it's quite possible that some of us could be a bit overwhelmed by the speed and amount of information we are receiving. If you're a little nervous, don't worry it will soon pass. Try to use this energy to examine and explore some new ways of looking at your life and your situations. You may come up with an unusual way of handling something that may have been giving you difficulty.

MERCURY SQUARES MARS:

On Friday July 29th at 4:49 P.M. EDT this intense and possibly angry aspect will push a lot of mental and verbal energy out into the public. If this sets off your chart you could be easily irritated and might overreact to some small slight. Egos will be prominent especially in all communications. Try to keep things in perspective and don't take the bait if someone is projecting their own anger in your direction. Use caution in all communications and while traveling. This is an argument or road rage waiting to happen. Don't let it happen to you. Sidestep any disputes that are not important enough to confront right now. If there is an issue that hasn't been resolved you may be better off waiting until this passes and then dealing with it. It makes little sense to antagonize someone when the energy is so fraught with tension.

URANUS RETROGRADES:

Also on Friday July 29th at 5:06 P.M. EDT this most unusual planet begins its yearly backward motion. Uranus rules electronics and the internet. While in retrograde there will be more problems with those devices we have all become so addicted to and complacent about. Computers may be more of a problem than usual. It also has much to do with electricity and there may be some issues there as well. In the human body, Mercury rules the RAM of the brain, while Uranus rules the HARD DRIVE, so to speak. This is a time when mediation and anything that centers your thoughts will be especially important. If you are nervous by nature you may feel this retrograde more intensely. In any case, it's important to calm your thoughts and allow the brain time to assimilate new information. Retrograde planets internalize the energy of that planet, and there may be too much data coming to you all at once.

MERCURY ENTERS VIRGO:

On Saturday July 30th at 2:19 P.M. EDT Mercury enters one of the 2 signs we give it rulership over. It does very well in this mutable earth sign and can be helpful in a number of ways. Virgo is very good with the little details, although it can be too critical at times. It's important not to get caught up in the small things and ignore the bigger picture. This is a good placement for all business issues. In the arts this is a great placement for editors or anyone whose attention to detail is required. Try not to be too picky or you could push people away. A good balance between honesty and compassion will help use this energy to your best advantage.

VENUS TRINES URANUS:

On Monday August 1st at 12:07 A.M. EDT this positive trine completes and we will all be looking for some excitement and adventure. This falls early in the morning, so its effects will be felt more strongly the night before. This is a time to take off the blinders and explore what the world has to offer. It's not a time to sit in front of a computer, but an opportunity to undertake a journey of exploration. This is followed by the Sun trine Saturn, (see below) a less enthusiastic transit that tends to deal more with responsibility, so try to enjoy this trine and get out and see what the universe has to offer.

THE SUN TRINES SATURN:

Also on Monday August 1st at 1:49 P.M. EDT this positive but rather dour transit will put us all into the mind frame of responsibilities and work. This isn't an exciting aspect, but it can be a very useful one. It's a good day to clean up your desk and put things in order. A realistic attitude will prevail, and business will be more on our minds than play. Because it is a positive trine we can make use of this mood without feeling trapped or restricted as many Saturn transits can do. Get your work done, make plans for the future, and as we approach the Dark of the Moon put down a strong foundation for next month.

MARS ENTERS SAGITTARIUS:

On Tuesday August 2nd at 1:49 P.M. EDT until September 27th Mars travels through the most expansive of signs. This can be a very positive transit as long as some precautions are taken. It's a good time to expand and push the usual limitations. You can attempt things that you may normally not try, and there is a sort of unfettered bravery this placement can project. Egos will be somewhat outrageous for the next 8 weeks as many people will project a very aggressive and outlandish persona, especially if this sets

off the individual's chart, so use some care as you approach others. As with most transits this has a potentially positive and negative side. There will be no shortage of arrogance and forcefulness. But it's important to avoid direct confrontations or bruised egos. This Jupiter-ruled sign has little use for boundaries, so it can be easy to offend or irritate others, especially if that person is usually shy or has hidden self-esteem issues. If your goal is to annoy them, then this is the time for such actions. But if you're trying to avoid confrontations, you must walk lightly and speak with a gentler voice. Otherwise you may inadvertently upset someone. Travel will be enjoyable and there are many adventures to seek out. But remember that everyone will be more outgoing and won't have the usual filters that normally prevent crossing over borders and restrictions.

DARK OF THE MOON:

The next New Moon falls on Tuesday August 2nd at 4:44 P.M. EDT at 10 degrees Leo 56 minutes. The day or two leading up to it will be a particularly low energy period. If you tend to be emotional this may be a very trying time each month. I have found that people with prominent moons or a Cancer Sun, Moon or ascendant respond to the lunar cycles more intensely than others. Spend this time finishing up anything that is incomplete, don't try to initiate new projects on a waning moon, it just won't work out. Once the New Moon hits you begin new projects or attempt a new approach to an existing problem. If you have been living in a situation or involved in a relationship that is intolerable or has outlived its usefulness this would be the proper time to move on with your life. If you have been working on a project that is almost complete but you seem to lack the energy for the finality, you must push during these low energy days to end the matter once and for all. If you don't, when the New Moon arrives it will bring this "dead" energy along with it and conflict with the newer force being presented. Each month we are offered a chance to clean house, so to speak.

Note: All aspects are most powerful and effective as they apply. Once the transit has completed, its force is lessened. The further it separates the weaker it becomes.

Below is a list of times this month when the Moon is Void of Course and neither important decisions nor purchases should be made during these periods. The Void of Course Moon is a time when we should try to center ourselves and deal with spiritual matters not materialistic ones. Any decisions made on the VC Moon will not turn out the way we had expected.

The Moon is Void of Course from the time it makes its last major aspect in a sign until it enters the next sign. For example, if the Moon squares Mars at 27 degrees Aries and then has no more aspects until it enters Taurus it will be Void of Course for three degrees or about 6 hours. The aspects used are the conjunction, sextile, square, trine, and opposition. All times are Eastern Daylight Time:
